

DENEYAP Technology Workshops Hold Project Festivals Across Türkiye

Simultaneous Technology Excitement in 81 Provinces

DENEYAP Technology Workshops, a pioneer in technology education across Türkiye, hosted a great event on July 5-6, 2025. **The Electronic Programming and Internet of Things Project Festival** was held simultaneously in 131 workshops across 81 provinces. At this major event, over **18,000 middle and high school students** shared their technology-focused projects with the public.

Projects from Innovative Minds Touching Real Life

This year, the main theme of the Project Festival was "**Emergency Warning and Response Systems.**" Students developed solutions for critical scenarios such as earthquakes, fires, floods, gas leaks, and health emergencies. Their prototypes utilized systems consisting of sensors for temperature, humidity, gas, motion, and light, as well as microcontrollers. Working in teams of 4-6 people, the students presented their projects to a jury in workshops in their respective cities. The systems developed by the students were evaluated not only on technical accuracy but also on innovation, originality, social benefit, and sustainability.

Juries Evaluated, Successful Teams Rewarded

The jury members conducted the evaluation process at the Project Festival, and the most successful teams were selected using a transparent and detailed scoring system. As part of the Electronic Programming and Internet of Things Project Festival, held simultaneously in 81 cities across Türkiye over two days, 1,310 students earned first-place awards from 18,539 students. At the end of the festival, certificates of achievement were presented to the winning teams, and the students' original ideas and projects were highly praised by the jury members and participants. During the event, T3 Foundation Chairperson Dr. Elvan Kuzucu Hıdır examined the students' projects on-site and expressed his appreciation for the visionary ideas put forward by these young people devoted to technology. Congratulating the winning teams, Kuzucu Hıdır emphasized that DENEYAP students are the young people who will build the future of Türkiye.
