TEKNOFEST Blue Homeland Visitor Registrations Have Started!

Visitor registrations have started for TEKNOFEST Blue Homeland, which will be organized within the scope of TEKNOFEST 2025 with the theme "Blue Homeland," the maritime reflection of the National Technology Initiative vision! The event, to be held on August 30–31 at Istanbul Naval Shipyard Command, offers you the opportunity to closely experience the maritime spirit. Participation in TEKNOFEST Blue Homeland is free of charge — you can reserve your spot now by registering online!

The world's largest aviation, space, and technology festival, TEKNOFEST, which has carried the vision of the National Technology Initiative from land to sea, is now bringing together technology and defense industry enthusiasts with a maritime focus under the theme "Blue Homeland." TEKNOFEST Blue Homeland, which will take place on **August 30–31 at Istanbul Naval Shipyard Command,** will introduce Turkey's power at sea and its advanced technological capabilities to young people, carrying the maritime culture into the future.

Focusing on maritime and underwater technologies, the event will host the Unmanned Underwater Systems Competition, the Underwater Rocket Competition, and the Unmanned Sea Vehicle Competition as part of TEKNOFEST Istanbul.

In addition, within the scope of TEKNOFEST Blue Homeland, distinguished ships of the Turkish Navy such as TCG Anadolu, TCG Istanbul, TCG Burgazada, TCG Oruçreis, TCG Nusret, TCG Sakarya, and TCG Hızırreis will be showcased. Visitors will also enjoy competitions aimed at preserving maritime culture, interactive gaming areas to be experienced with virtual reality goggles, special shows by the SAT and SAS Commands, the "Blue Homeland Time Tunnel" event reflecting maritime history, and a variety of conferences and exhibitions offering many colorful activities that will create unforgettable moments.

Visitor registrations have started for TEKNOFEST Blue Homeland!

Participation is completely free, but visitors must register online to enter TEKNOFEST Blue Homeland. As participation is limited, a separate ticket must be issued for each attendee. Children under the age of 7 are not required to register. Visitor entry and exit to the event area will be between 09:00 and 18:00. Meanwhile, visitors who have an account on NSosyal, Turkey's domestic and national social media platform developed by the T3 Foundation and young entrepreneurs participating in TEKNOFEST, will be granted priority entry if the phone number or email address they provide during registration matches their NSosyal account.



Visits will take place in three separate sessions throughout the day:

Session: 12:00 - 15:00
Session: 15:00 - 18:00
