

DENEYAP Türkiye Instructors from 81 Provinces Gather in Mersin

DENEYAP Türkiye will bring together 580 instructors working at 131 DENEYAP Technology Workshops across 81 provinces through the “Instructor Training Program,” to be held at the Mersin Youth Camp between November 21–23, 2025.

This comprehensive program stands out as one of DENEYAP Türkiye’s most important annual gatherings, aiming to enhance the quality of education, align content with current technology trends, and deepen the professional development of instructors.

This year’s program will gain additional significance through special celebrations dedicated to Teachers’ Day on November 24, featuring a dedicated segment that highlights the dedication, sacrifice, and contributions of instructors in a warm and engaging atmosphere. Following the three-day training program, participants will conclude the experience with a cultural excursion to the Cennet–Cehennem Caves, one of Mersin’s unique natural heritages.
